Dear Attorney General Moore,

After recently seeing the documentary film *The Murder of Emmett Till*, I urge you to reinvestigate the 1955 murder of this 14-year-old boy. As one of the last unresolved cases from the civil rights era, Till's murder remains an ugly mark on the history of Mississippi and the United States.

It is not too late. There are witnesses, and possibly perpetrators, still alive. I implore you, as the chief legal officer for the State of Mississippi, to locate living witnesses, reassess the role of the state 48 years ago, and seek justice, at long last, in the murder of Emmett Till.
